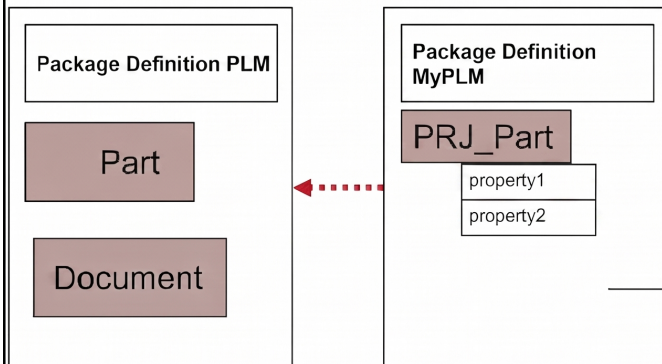


Case 2

Packaging Scenarios – Case 2

This case applies when your project needs to create relationships between new Item Types and existing Item Types from Released AML Packages.



Recommended practices for this scenario:

- If you do not customize Released AML Packages, there is no need to store them in the repository.
- If you do customize Released AML Packages, store only the delta of your changes rather than the full package.
- Minimize changes to Released AML Packages to ensure smoother upgrades.
- Define your new items.
- Define your new relationships to existing items property pointers.
- Define your forms. Do all this without altering the existing items.
- Update your import.mf to indicate your dependencies.

<package name="com.myproject.PLM" path="myproject/plm/Import">  
  <dependson name="com.aras.innovator.solution.PLM" />

```

- Enable `Import.AutoResolveItemDependency` so the import process calculates the order of items from actual item-to-item dependencies instead of package-level dependencies.
- Use Package Studio or DevOps Studio to submit AML changes.
