

Known Issues in ProAppDesigner

Issue #	Description	Workaround
645	Conditional Formatting: The background color is still editable when the color picker is open.	
725	Section and Group Control: Font size settings do not apply to Section and Group controls.	
858	Font color does not work for the X Classification control.	
960	Template: Changing an existing dashboard template type to Advanced View should mark the existing wizard as an error (in red), but it does not.	
966	Worksheet: The context menu does not disappear after you click toolbar icons.	
985	Structural changes (inserting or deleting child items across assemblies) do not update consistently across all levels of the Sub-Assembly structure.	
1019	Reload Control API: The reloadControl API does not discard changes made to form controls.	
1020	When a control is added in a wizard with an associated type (context) and the same control is added in a dialog with an associated type (Type), the data fails to save after clicking Save or Done.	
1053	Collection Control: After adding a new table and selecting columns, updates made in the table settings flyout (like column width changes or removing columns) do not apply after clicking OK.	
1081	The control settings flyout does not display a title.	
1083	Default values do not appear for a property in Preview mode—they only show during actual item creation.	
1092	Page Settings: The flyout takes a long time to close after selecting an icon.	
1108	In Preview mode, selecting Discard does not work, and you cannot navigate between pages.	
1138	In the read-only and display condition, the Expression field is added even when no value is entered.	
1187	Worksheet: When grouping is enabled, numbers still display with decimals.	



1229	File Control: Tooltip labels are required for the Upload, Download, and Cancel icons, and for controls in the drag-and-drop area.	
1286	Plain Text Content Control and Rich Text Content Control do not keep formatting like line breaks (“New Line”) in generated reports.	
1295	Table rows disappear when you scroll down and back up and take time to reload—especially with large tables (for example, more than two hundred rows and at least 36 columns).
