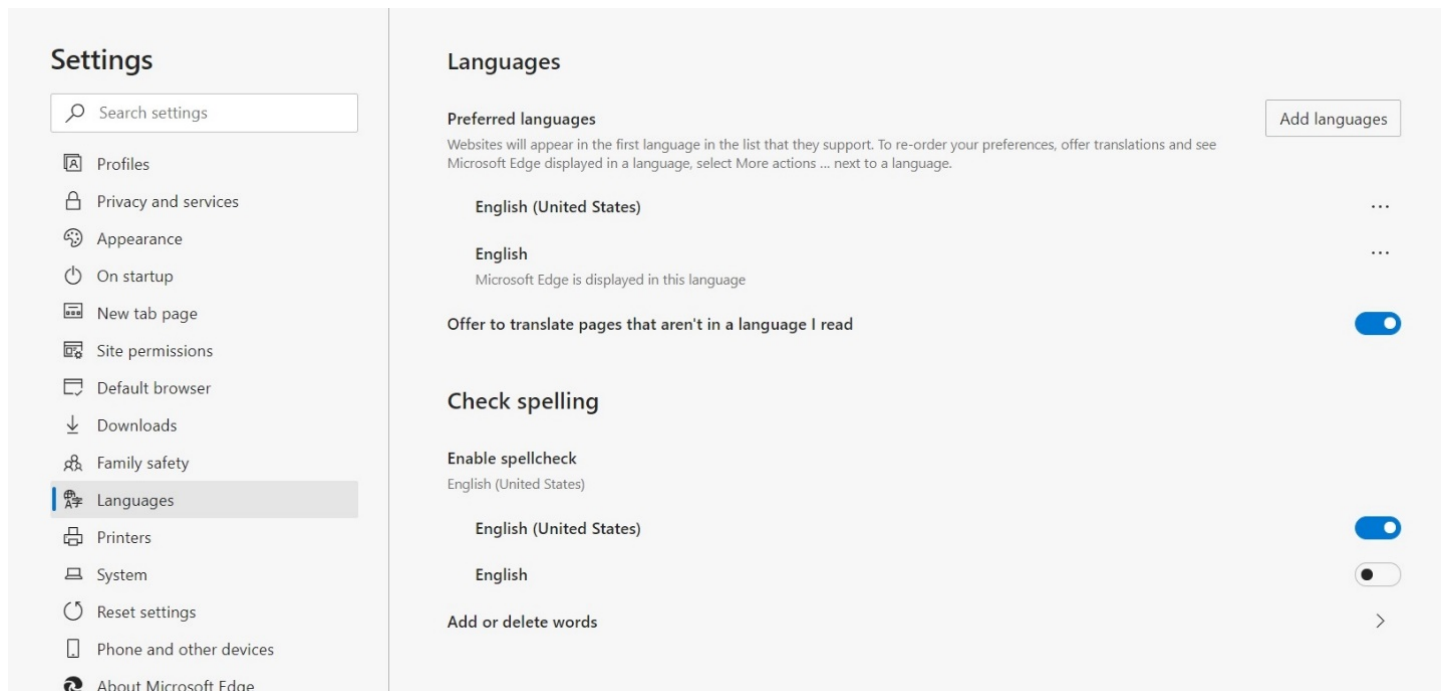

Defining user's Locale in Browser

Microsoft Edge Chromium

1. Open the Microsoft Edge browser and go to Settings --> Languages.
2. Click on Add Languages.



3. In the Add Languages dialog box, select a language such as Japanese.

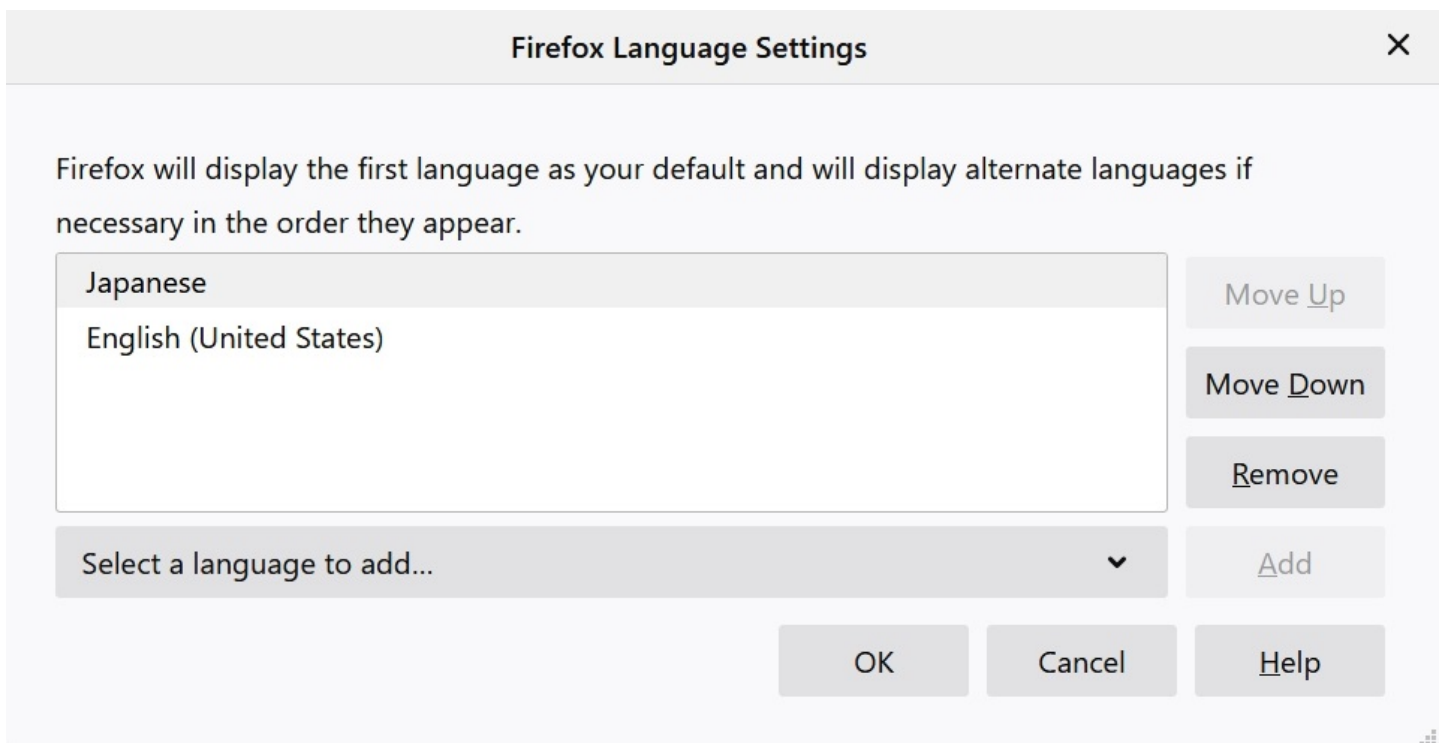

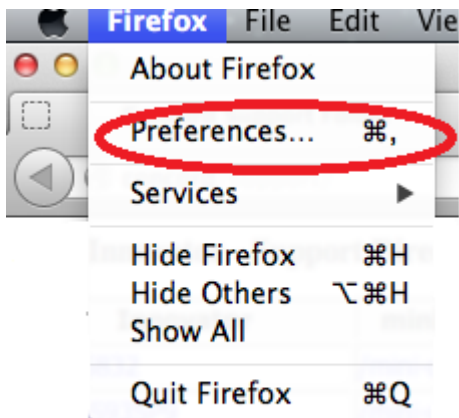
7. Click **Move Down** to move Japanese to the bottom of the list.



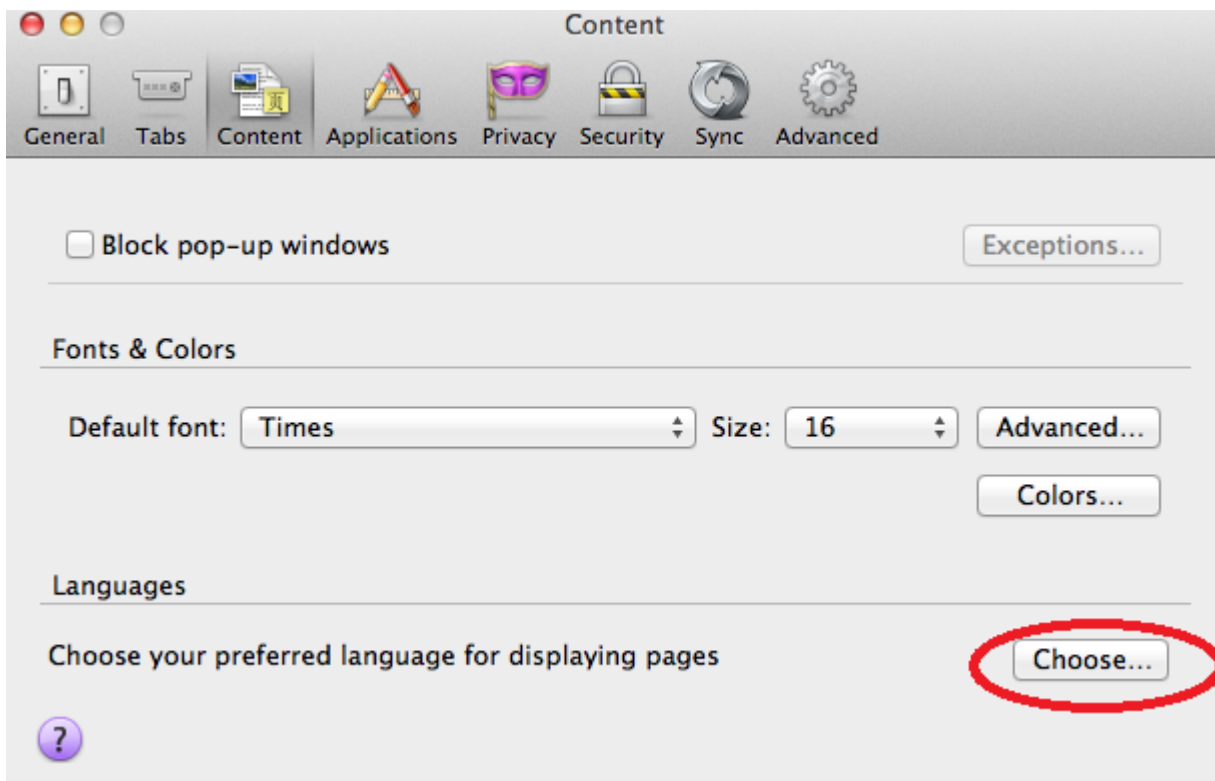
8. Close the browser.

3. For Languages, click Choose.



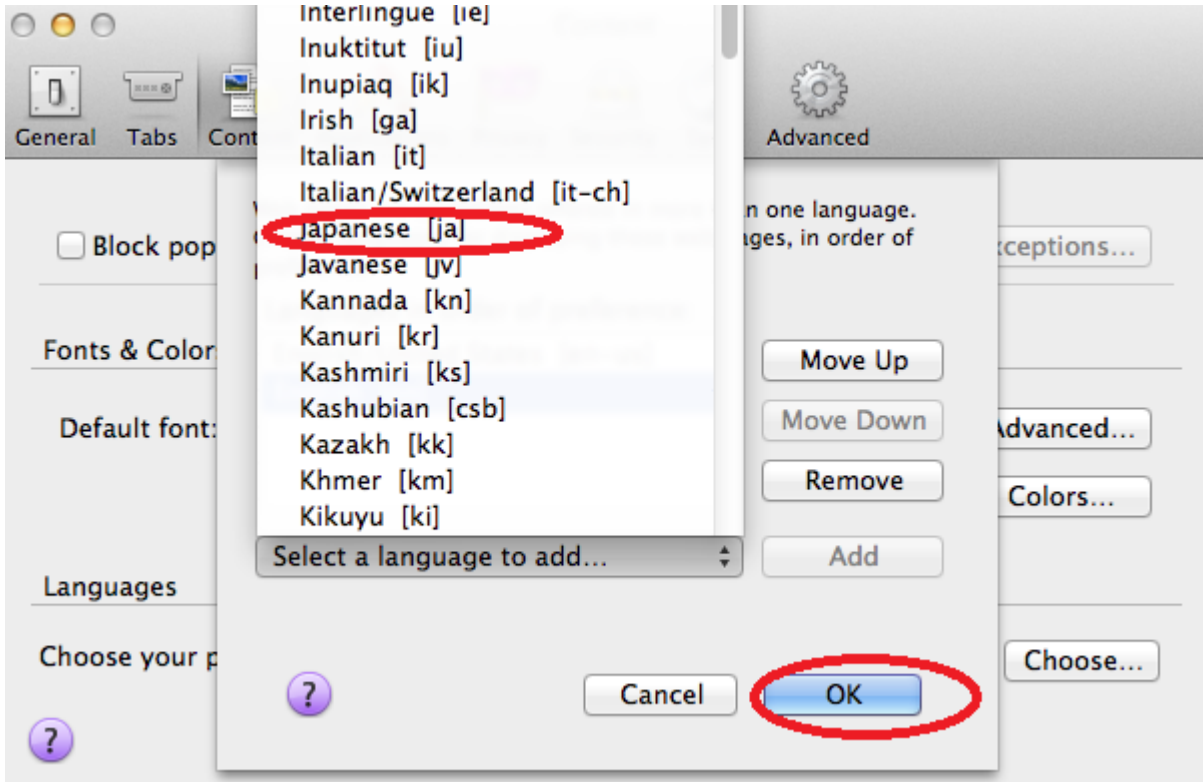
4. Click Select a language to add....





5. Select a language. For example, Japanese [ja-JP].

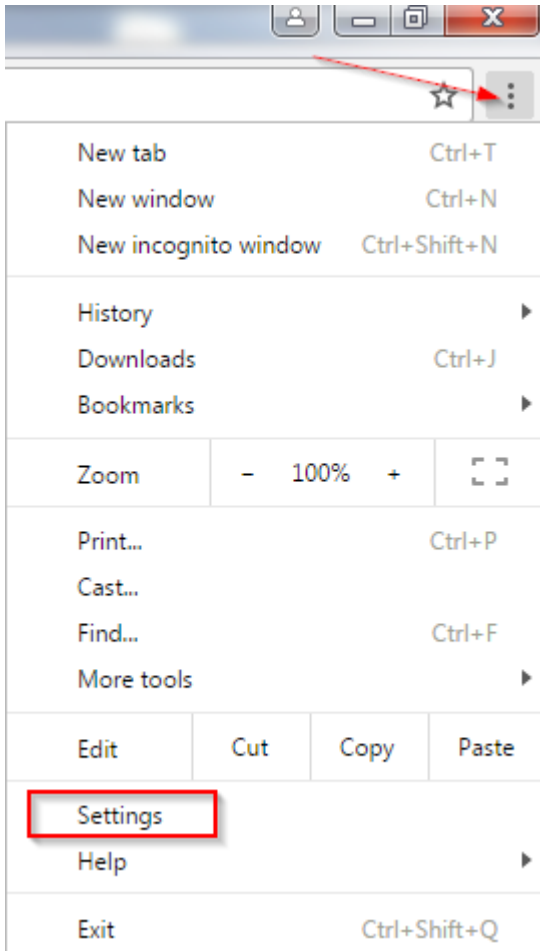




6. Click Add and move it to the top.
